JURY CONVICTS MAN OF MURDER AT BEECHER LIQUOR STORE

FLINT – Genesee County Prosecutor David Leyton announced that a jury has convicted a 19-year-old Flint man of murder connected to the fatal shooting of a customer outside a local liquor store.

Aaron Dominique Ivory was charged and convicted of three felonies including first degree murder, armed robbery, and felony firearm related to the December 2, 2013 fatal shooting of 42-year-old Lance Pavlow outside the Beecher Beer and Wine Store on N. Saginaw Street in Mt. Morris Township. He faces life in prison without the possibility of parole.

"The victim was a husband and a father of a young child whose life was cut far too short by an armed robber's bullet," said Prosecutor Leyton after the verdict was read. "While we can never bring Lance Pavlow back to life to share in the raising of his child, I am pleased we were able to see justice through in holding his killer responsible for his actions," Leyton said.

Pavlow is scheduled to be sentenced on November 10th.
