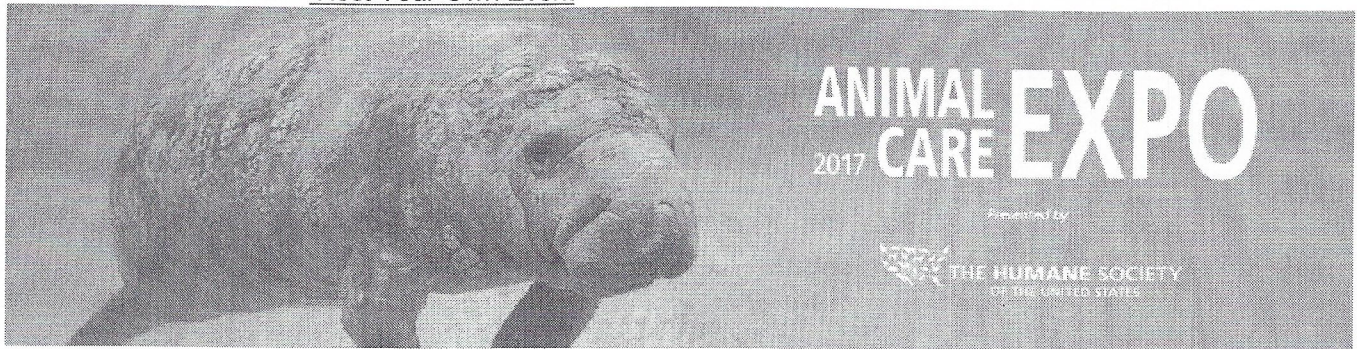

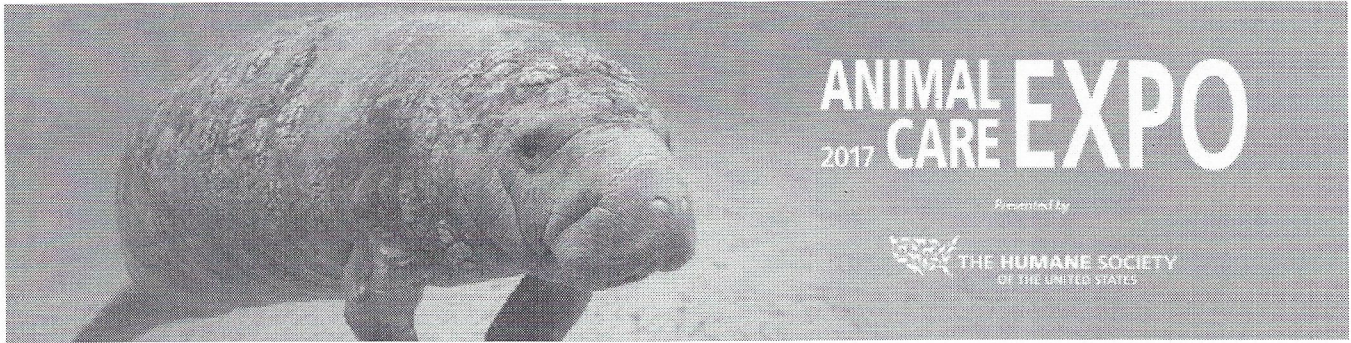

Background:

Genesee County's FY 2018 Community Corrections Comprehensive Plan application is expected to be submitted to the Michigan Department of Corrections-Office of Community Corrections (MDOC-OCC) by May 1, 2017.

Genesee County's community corrections administration and programming budget for FY 2017, under its Community Corrections Comprehensive Plan, was \$515,186. The FY 2018 budget is expected to be the same amount as FY 2017.

The funding proposal is divided among two general program areas and comprehensive plan administration. The funding allocations by general program areas and plan administration are:

- General Plans and Services: \$342,030;
- Plan Administration: \$113,000;
- Drunk Driving Jail Reduction Program: \$60,156

Budget attached.
