Dear Commissioner Curtis,

The Office of Senior Services (OSS) is in support of the recommendation to dissolve the Senior Citizens Services Advisory Committee (SCSAC). We agree that in the early years of the Senior Millage it was necessary to have a committee of dedicated, skilled, and educated community representatives to provide oversight on how the senior millage funds were going to be best utilized and disbursed to the appropriate agencies.

However, since OSS has been formed, the staff have absorbed all of the oversight tasks as well as obtaining feedback from the community and have made the majority of the recommendations to the committee. The OSS staff has also taken over the duties of the part-time secretary, the GIS/mapping position, and the accountant. Since, our office deals with the everyday operations of the senior centers and service providers, it is felt that the dissolution of SCSAC would allow staff more time to complete tasks. On an average, approximately 15 hours a month is dedicated to preparing for the subcommittee and SCSAC meetings, preparation of minutes, traveling, income and expense statements, and memorandums.

Dissolving SCSAC would also be a cost savings to the Senior Millage funding, as the County pays annual per diem stipends to the committee members, reimbursement for mileage, and also the time it takes away for the senior centers directors and service providers to travel to and from the meetings.

We are confident that we will continue make the appropriate recommendations to the Human Service Committee, and if necessary at times call a sub-committee meeting of the HSC.

Dear Lynn,

In 2006, the County Board of Commissioners approved a comprehensive Plan for the Genesee County Senior Citizen Services Millage (rev.060506) which in part, identified the need to appoint an Advisory Committee. Once established, the Senior Citizen Services Advisory Committee had the responsibility of organizing and prioritizing senior citizen needs and incorporating the necessary measures to effectively mobilize the distribution of funds.

During the past ten years, the SCSAC Committee Members have done a tremendous job assisting in the creation of a format and mechanism required to appropriately distribute senior millage revenue. They worked diligently with the Planning Commission, Corporation Counsel, and the County Board of Commissioners in developing proper procedures, RFP's, applications, and reporting forms to assist in performance review and evaluations involving every agency receiving millage revenue.

In addition, the SCSAC Committee, in conjunction with the County Board of Commissioners and Corporation Counsel, established the Office of Senior Services in FY2010-2011. The main function of OSS is to oversee the distribution of funds, and provide recipient oversight ensuring the appropriate use of tax payer dollars in the community.

Since, the SCSAC Committee has helped create the necessary infrastructure for the distribution and oversight of the senior millage funds, and with that now completed, it seems there may be a better use of time for staff, committee members and commissioners. On behalf of the Senior Center Directors, I support dissolving the SCSAC Committee.

In closing, if SCSAC is dissolved, the directors would still like to have the opportunity to meet with OSS Staff, at least quarterly, to be updated on any concerns, budget information, changes regarding documenting or reporting processes. This would also provide valuable time to

exchange information, and discuss new ideas and trends that may need to be considered to better serve the senior community.

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Genesee County, Michigan, authorized on September 8, 2015, in Resolution no. 15-363, a contract award in the amount of \$113,826 funded with senior millage funds between Genesee County and the United Senior Network ("USN"), a non-profit organization, to operate the Hasselbring Senior Center in the City of Flint; and

WHEREAS, concurrent with the contract award, an audit was performed by Gabridge and Company ("Gabridge") of USN's fiscal July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Gabridge issued a disclaimer of opinion due to its inability to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence required to substantiate material amounts of revenues, expenses, capital assets, and long term liabilities; and

WHEREAS, Resolution no. 15-363 approved a contract that would substantially conform to the contract submitted, and a final contract has not been drafted or executed pending the results of the audit; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires the continuation of the services provided at the Hasselbring Senior Center, but must require responsible financial management of senior millage funding and, due to the significant number and severity of issues identified by the audit, determines that additional contractual oversight and constraints must be placed on the USN as a condition of continued funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board of Commissioners of Genesee County, Michigan, that the request by the Director of the Genesee County

Office of Senior Services ("GCOSS") to authorize the inclusion in the operational contract of certain contractual terms, designed to assist USN in improving its financial management and to provide the necessary oversight by the Office of Senior Services and this Board, are approved as follows:
