44-year-old man was arraigned

on murder and robbery charges

in the **deaths** of two people last

weekend in Flint Township.

Marcus D. Lanes stood in front

of Genesee District Judge John

Conover this afternoon.

Charles F. Woodson, 78, and his daughter, Phyllis Woodson, 53, were found dead on Saturday

in their home at Clovertree Apartments.

Conover set a Dec. 13 date for a preliminary examination.

Police believe he was robbing the two when they were killed.

"We understand the severity of the charges," said his attorney Erwin Meiers.

Lanes also is believed to have barricaded himself at the East Village Inn on Sunday for about four hours. There have been no charges filed in that matter.
