JURY CONVICTS FLINT MAN IN DRUGS, WEAPONS, AND PROSTITUTION CASE

FLINT – Genesee County Prosecutor David Leyton reported that a jury convicted a Flint man on Friday on felony drug and weapons charges.

Anthony Jequinn Gray, 52 (9-29-61), was found guilty of two counts of possession with intent to deliver cocaine and heroin, accepting the earnings of a prostitute, being a felon in possession of a firearm, and felony firearm.

The investigation into the case began with reports of a missing woman who was a struggling heroin addict and was suspected of being held against her will and used for prostitution by Gray. Law enforcement officers with the Flint Area Narcotics Group (F.A.N.G.) were conducting surveillance of defendant's home when a traffic stop was made of a vehicle leaving his residence. The traffic stop resulted in drugs being discovered in the vehicle and further information led investigators to obtain a search warrant of the home where more drugs, guns, and two women who had been working as prostitutes were found.

Gray is scheduled to be sentenced on March 31st.
