TRIO CONVICTED IN 2010 MURDER OF TIMOTHY BAKER

FLINT -- Three men have been convicted in the 2010 murder of 39-year-old Timothy Baker after a jury returned with its verdict this morning.

Devonte Dwayne Reid, 20 (d.o.b. 3/18/1992), and Quentin Lamar Green, 19 (d.o.b. 7/13/1992), were each convicted of first degree felony murder and the third defendant, Latrell Demetrius Windom, 19 (d.o.b. 6/23/1993), was convicted of second degree murder in the death of Baker's. All three men were also convicted of two counts of assault with intent to murder and felony firearm.

Baker was shot and killed on December 12, 2010 during a drug deal and robbery at his home on Ridgeway Avenue in the City of Flint. Two other individuals in the home at the time were also assaulted with one victim being paralyzed after being shot.

Prosecutors were able to show ballistic matches and DNA evidence as part of their case. The autopsy report showed Baker suffered seven bullet wounds. Prosecutors also credited neighbors for coming forth and testifying in the case.

Sentencing is scheduled for July 31, 2012.
