Two Convicted Related to an Armed Robbery of a Flint Township Woman Last Summer

FLINT -- Genesee County Prosecutor David Leyton said guilty verdicts have been returned against two Flint men who robbed a Flint Township woman while she was unloading groceries from her car.

A jury convicted Eric Roshawn Smith, 32 (d.o.b. 6-22-80) of armed robbery, felony firearm, and being a felon in possession of a firearm for the June 25th incident at Clovertree Apartments in Flint Township. Smith faces a possible sentence of life in prison on the armed robbery conviction.

A co-defendant, Anthony Dunbar, 33 (d.o.b. 9-15-79) also of Flint, was convicted of felony firearm and being a felon in possession of a firearm related to the same incident. He was acquitted of an armed robbery charge.

The Prosecutor's office will be seeking an enhanced penalty based on their prior felony convictions when Smith and Dunbar are sentenced.

"We continue to battle crime on the streets of our community through the criminal justice system in the courts," said Prosecutor Leyton.

"The challenges are great but we continue to do all we can to bring justice to victims and take the bad guys off the streets," he said.
