The New Hire Process....

If you accepted a position, the following must be completed before you begin employment:

Step 1 - A background check will be performed.

Completion time varies as each background is unique allow - up to two weeks for results. Once confirmed, you will be contacted by HR.

<u>Step 2</u> - HR will contact you with instructions for the pre-employment physical. You will also receive details for orientation and the steps to take to prepare for orientation.

<u>Step 3</u> - Once the pre-employment physical is completed, you will attend orientation.

Employees have a choice of Blue Cross/ Blue Shield or Health Alliance Plan.

Dental/Vision/Life Insurance:

Offered at no cost to full time benefit employees.

Holidays:

Up to 14 paid holidays per year.

Time Off:

Employees usually receive both vacation and personal hours for paid time off.

Tuition Reimbursement:

Offered on an annual basis after completing probationary period.

Retirement:

Employer contribution of 8% or 10% Employees choose 3%, 5% or 7%



Deferred Compensation:

Voluntary employee participation as a retirement supplement.

Short/Long Term Disability:

Coverage provided at no premium cost to employee

Notional Account:

In lieu of retiree healthcare, Genesee County contributes \$50 or \$100 per pay to an account for retirement healthcare costs.

Career Change/Advancement:

There is a broad range of positions throughout the county.
