

Resolution #67-18

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN INCORPORATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville is subject to annexation from adjoining cities and villages which erodes the Town's tax base and leave the Town's borders insecure; and

WHEREAS, towns in the State of Wisconsin are limited in the use of certain economic development tools that are otherwise available to villages and cities; and

WHEREAS, As a town in the State of Wisconsin, the Town of Greenville derives limited authority to control planning and zoning issues within the Town compared to the authority provided to cities and villages; and

WHEREAS, with a population over 11,785 residents the Town of Greenville is larger than 389 of the 411 other villages in the State of Wisconsin and is the second largest town in the state; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville is a full service municipality offering directed law enforcement, fire, water, sanitary sewer, street, parks, recreation & forestry and stormwater services to its residents; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville may benefit from seeking incorporation as a village in the State of Wisconsin as incorporated municipalities receive the benefits of border protection, increased use of certain economic development tools, and increased control over the planning and zoning issues within its borders; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of an Incorporation Oversight Committee would allow a group of residents to research, review, discuss, receive public input, and develop a list of positive attributes and negative attributes to seeking incorporation as a village.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Greenville hereby establishes an Incorporation Oversight Committee to research, review, discuss, receive public input, and develop an application seeking incorporation as a village for submission to the Wisconsin Department of Administration's Incorporation Review Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Incorporation Oversight Committee will consist of up to seven (7) residents of the Town of Greenville appointed by the Town Chairperson. The members of the ad hoc committee will serve from the time of their appointment until February 28, 2019 at which time the committee automatically dissolves unless modified by future Town Board action.
