**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A
CONTRACT FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO DETERMINE THE
COST ASSOCIATED WITH MAKING CITY HALL ADA COMPLIANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson wishes to explore those improvements and renovations necessary to make Hudson City Hall ADA compliant; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council previously authorized the Mayor City to issue a request for proposal ("RFP") seeking a firm to conduct a feasibility study on the costs associated with making City Hall ADA Compliant; and

WHEREAS, Lacey Thaler Reilly Wilson Architecture & Preservation, LLP's bid of \$32,000 was the lowest responsible bidder to the RFP;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Hudson to execute a contract with Lacey Thaler Reilly Wilson Architecture & Preservation, LLP for \$32,000.00 to conduct a feasibility study on the cost to make Hudson City Hall ADA compliant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to make the following budget amendment:
