These are the local and statewide guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID:

REDUCE INTERACTIONS

If you leave your rental, reduce the number of interactions you have with people.

STAY SIX FEET APART

If you leave your rental, keep a safe distance of six feet from others outside your party.

WEAR A MASK

If you leave your rental, use a mask or make your own from cloth.

WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN

Wash with soap and water often for 20 seconds. If none are available, use alcohol-based hand sanitizers.

CALL THE DOCTOR

If you are experiencing flu-like symptoms, stomach upset, or loss of smell: call your doctor, Columbia Memorial Health hotline at (518) 828-8249, or Columbia County Public Health Department at (518) 828-3358. In an emergency call 911.


Please know that Hudson residents do express their concern about non-compliance and the City of Hudson agencies and services are pro-actively reminding residents.
