City Council Election: November 7, 2017

The City Council election will be held in the basement of City Hall from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, November 7, 2017**.

Absentee ballots are available if you meet one of the following conditions:

- Are 60 years of age or older;
- Expect to be absent from the community in which you are registered to vote for the entire time the polls are open on election day;
- Are physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another;
- Cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of your religion;
- Have been appointed as an election inspector in a precinct other than the precinct in which you reside; or
- Cannot attend the polls because you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial.

An application must be on file with the Clerk's office in your jurisdiction to obtain an absentee ballot. For City residents, applications are available at City Hall or on the city's website at

The Clerk's Office will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day to issue Absentee Ballots. In addition, the Clerk's Office will be open at City Hall from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 4, 2017 to issue absentee ballots. New Black River Park Skid Piers

The city's Black River Park now features newly completed "skid piers" for the boat launch area. The skid piers were partially funded by a grant from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR.) The MDNR provided \$37,500, with the city providing a \$12,500 local match, to fund the construction of the new skid piers. The city was able to complete the construction of three (3) of the five (5) piers as part of the project. The city has already applied for MDNR funding to help fund the remaining piers which need replacement.
