## South Haven Area Emergency Services to Host Citizen Fire Academy

South Haven Area Emergency Services (SHAES) will be hosting its biennial Citizen Fire Academy from March 15 to May 17, 2017. The Citizen Fire Academy is a course designed to give the public a working knowledge of the SHAES personnel and policies. It is a series of classes held once per week for ten weeks and also includes a graduation.



The SHAES Citizen Fire Academy is intended to provide information that will enable citizens to improve safety in their homes, the work place, and homes of families around them. Attendees will also gain a fundamental understanding of how their fire department functions and the tools necessary to accomplish the variety of tasks that can be assigned to it.

The SHAES Citizen Fire Academy covers such diverse topics as laws, regulations, hazardous materials, self-contained breathing apparatus, thermal imaging cameras, CPR, portable fire extinguishers, fire inspections, fire investigations, forcible entry, ventilation, vehicle extrication, confined space/rope rescue and structural fire-fighting. Instruction consists of hands-on involvement supplemented by lecture, tours, videos, and demonstrations.

Just a few reminders...

- Beginning on November 15th, no parking is allowed on any City street between 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. to allow for snow removal. This parking restriction will be in effect until March 15, 2017.
- The City of South Haven mailed the Winter 2017 Property Tax bills the first week of December. If you have not received your bill please call (269) 637-0700 or visit the Parcel Records area of the City's website at [www.south-haven.com](http://www.south-haven.com). **Winter taxes are due on February 14th.**

- The Assessing Office will be mailing assessment notices to each property owner within the City limits at the end of February. The assessment notices show several important figures. These include the State Equalized Value, the Assessed Value, and the Taxable Value of your property for the 2016 tax years. For more information, contact the assessing office at (269) 637-0745.
- Trash containers should not be placed in the parkway more than 24 hours before pick-up. Also, the containers shall be removed no more than 24 hours following pick-up.
