Election Day: May 2nd

Absentee ballots for the May 2, 2017 election are available from your city or township clerk if you meet one of the following conditions:

- Are 60 years of age or older.
- Expect to be absent from the community in which you are registered to vote for the entire time the polls are open on election day.
- Are physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another.
- Cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of your religion.
- Have been appointed as an election inspector in a precinct other than the precinct in which you reside.
- Cannot attend the polls because you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial.

An application must be filed with the Clerk's Office in your jurisdiction to obtain an absentee ballot. For City residents, applications are available on the City's website at www.south-haven.com or at City Hall.

The City of South Haven Clerk's Office will be open from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. each day to issue Absentee Ballots. In addition, the City of South Haven Clerk's Office will be open at City Hall from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 29, 2017 for issuing absentee ballots. Please call your city or township clerk for more information on Absentee Ballots or the election.

Spring Cleanup Reminder

The City of South Haven is currently running a spring leaf pickup. To assist the city street crew, please rake your leaves to the parkway (the area between the sidewalk and the street).

Please do not rake them into the street. Doing so will clog the storm drains and also make it difficult for the leaf truck to pick-up your leaves.

Once your leaves are in the parkway, please call the Department of Public Works at (269) 637-0737. The department is responding to individual calls for pickup, and doing so will add your address to the list.

After May 27th all lawn debris must be placed in approved lawn bags and branches must be bundled up and tied in 3ft long bundles. This can then be placed out on the normal garbage collection day and will be taken away by Republic Disposal.
