





Next steps for St. Marys

- Creation of St. Marys Marine Center Community Improvement District (CID)
 - JDA and St. Marys staff author legislation
 - Allows developer/owner to request additional millage that can then be used to finance public aspects of project.
 - Authority will request cooperation from City and legislation to create CID by December.
