### Water Tower Removal

On Monday, October 14, 2019, beginning at 6am a Contactor will be on-site removing the water tower at the U.S. Fish & Wildlife building at the intersection of Fletcher Street and Cedar Street.

For the safety of the public, Fletcher Street between Pine and Cedar and also Cedar Street between Fletcher and Oldfield will be closed to all traffic and pedestrians.

The bikepath along Fletcher Street as well as along the Thunder Bay River will also be closed at sections adjacent to this work.

Due to the Columbus Day holiday, both NOAA and US Fish and Wildlife are closed on Monday.

This work is expected to be completed by 5pm Monday.
