



Northeast Michigan Materials Management Authority Clean-Up Day May 6, 2023

News Release:

The 2023 Clean-up Day will be held on Saturday, May 6, 2023, at the north parking lot of the Northern Lights Arena located at 751 Woodward Avenue, Alpena, MI. We ask that residents line up behind the barriers on the last driveway off Woodward Avenue. The collection will start at 8am till 1pm. This clean-up day is not funded by the \$20.00 annual recycling fee paid on your tax bill but funded from donations from local governing bodies. The 2022 collection cost was \$25,000.00.

The following items will be accepted:

Tires: Each resident is allowed up to 10 tires for FREE. If any of those 10 free tires have rims, there will be an extra charge of \$1.00 each. After the 10 free tires, there will be a charge of \$2.00 per tire and \$1.00 extra for any rims. Farmers will be allowed one (1) tractor tire without a rim. Each additional tractor tire will cost \$70.00.

White goods: The following white good appliances are the only ones accepted for FREE on Clean-up Day: electric and gas stoves, microwaves and water heaters.

Each resident will be allowed to drop off one (1) freon unit FREE of charge. Additional freon units will cost \$10.00 each.

Old furniture such as couches, chairs and tables are FREE.

Each resident will be allowed any combination of two (2) mattresses or box springs. Additional mattresses and box springs will cost \$10.00 each.

NO household hazardous waste will be accepted such as cleaners, aerosols, solvents, paint, automotive cleaners, light bulbs, and fertilizers.

Absolutely NO household garbage or construction material will be accepted on Clean-up Day. If residents come with household garbage or construction material, they will be directed to our facility on M-32 to dispose of for a fee.

Cash, check, credit and debit cards will be accepted.
