ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee ballots for the November 2, 2021, General Election are available at the City Clerk's Office for City voters who desire to obtain an absent voter's ballot. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The Clerk's office will be open on **Saturday, October 30, 2021, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.** to request an absentee ballot.

Electors may obtain an absent voter ballot or spoil their ballot and receive a new ballot **via First Class mail up to 5 p.m. on October 29, 2021.**

Electors who have returned their absent voter ballot may submit a written request to spoil their absent voter ballot and receive a new ballot in the Clerk's office by **10 a.m. on November 1, 2021.**

Electors may obtain an absent voter ballot in person in the Clerk's office or electors who have lost their absent voter ballot or not yet received their ballot in the mail may submit a written request in person to spoil their absent voter ballot and receive a new ballot in the Clerk's office by **4 p.m. on November 1, 2021.**

Emergency absentee voting is available up to **4 p.m. on November 2, 2021.**

Election Day new voter registrants may obtain and vote an absent voter ballot in person in the Clerk's office with proof of residency or vote in person in the proper precinct. This is available up to **8 p.m. on November 2, 2021.**

Reminder: a requirement of absentee voting is that every voter who obtains an absentee ballot in person must show picture identification or sign an affidavit attesting that he or she is not in possession of picture identification.

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
