BAGLEY STREET BRIDGE OVER THUNDER BAY RIVER REHABILITATION

The Alpena County Road Commission wants to inform motorists that work will resume Monday, April 18, 2022, weather permitting, on the Bagley Street Bridge rehabilitation project. The project is located on Bagley Street at the Thunder Bay River crossing.

Beginning on this date (April 18, 2022) the Bagley Street Bridge will be closed to all traffic.

A detour route has been established utilizing M-32, Ripley Boulevard, 11th Avenue, Chisholm Street and Long Rapids Road. This detour route has been established as the most efficient route available to service all motorists needs.

Local residents are encouraged to seek alternate routes that may better suit their needs.

Bagley Street will be closed from the Alpena County Road Commission driveway to the Word of Life Baptist Church. Access to Burkholder Drive will be maintained at all times.

In addition to this closure the traffic control signal located at the intersection of Long Rapids Road/Bagley Street/Genschaw Rd will be placed in flash mode allowing for more efficient travel throughout the detour route for the duration of the Bagley Street Bridge Closure.

This closure is expected to last approximately 6 weeks. Residents and businesses should plan accordingly.

The Alpena County Road Commission would like to thank you in advance for your patience as we continue our efforts to improve the county road system.
