Street Closure & Water Shut Off Notice

Due to construction delays, the planned street closure and water shut off scheduled for Tuesday, October 20, 2020, has been delayed until Wednesday, October 21, 2020.

Beginning Tuesday, October 20, 2020, First Avenue, from Wisner Street to Blair Street, including Blair Street and Wisner Street intersection, will be closed to all traffic due to water valve replacement.

Additionally, water will be shut off on Tuesday, October 20, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. until approximately 5:00 p.m.

The following areas will be affected by the water shut off:

S. First Avenue from Crapo Street to Bingham Street
Bingham Street from Clinton Street to Second Avenue
Clinton Street from Bingham Street to Barry Street
Blair Street from S. First Avenue to S. Second Avenue
S. Second Avenue from Blair Street to Crapo Street

Please anticipate your water needs before water is shut off.

When water is restored refrain from drinking, doing laundry, washing dishes or food preparation until water runs clear.

When water is restored there **may be** a boil water notice until two consecutive bacteria samples have been approved. This will take at least two days. **You will be notified if a boil water is required.**

Signage and barricades will be present to guide traffic around the construction site, but motorists are advised to seek alternate routes.

This closure is expected to take one (1) day to complete unless weather or construction delays occur. In case of inclement weather, work will take place the following day.
