Dog Law Reminders

The City of Alpena Police Department would like to address recent concerns of citizens related to responsibilities they take on as dog owners.

- No person shall allow a dog to run at large or stray beyond the premises of the owner.
- A dog not on its owner's property shall be required to be on a leash and under the reasonable control of its owner.
- A dog that is tied up or leashed on its owner's unfenced property shall be secured in such a way that it is not able to get within two feet of any lot line of the property.
- It is unlawful to permit any dog to be in any park or on city property unless such dog is on a leash and under reasonable control of its owner.
