## FALL WATER MAIN FLUSHING PROGRAM

The City of Alpena Water/Wastewater Utility will be conducting seasonal water main flushing according to the following schedule. This annual task is conducted to remove internal sediment from the distribution system prior to winter weather conditions.

Flushing activities are scheduled during nighttime hours to minimize traffic conflicts and negative impacts on normal water usage.

**SEPTEMBER 20, 2021 – SEPTEMBER 24, 2021**

**Monday, September 20, 2021 – 7:00 PM to 1:00 AM**

The area between State Street and Sixth Avenue from Ripley Boulevard to the Thunder Bay River.

**Tuesday, September 21, 2021 – 7:00 PM to 1:00 AM**

The area between Seventh Avenue to Fourteenth Avenue from Washington/Eleventh Avenue to Thunder Bay River.  
The area between Grant Street and Third Avenue west of Ripley Boulevard to Hobbs Drive.

**Wednesday, September 22, 2021 – 7:00 PM to 1:00 AM**

The area between Fourth Avenue and Washington Avenue west of Ripley Boulevard to Bagley Street.  
Bagley Street from M32 to Bridge.  
The area between Ford Avenue and Walnut Street from Fletcher Street to Wessel Road.

**Thursday, September 23, 2021 – 7:00 PM to 1:00 AM**

The area between Bolton Street and Commerce Drive from Long Lake Avenue to Hueber Street.  
Johnson Street, Woodward Avenue and the hospital area to U.S. 23 North.  
Long Rapids Road from U.S. 23 to Bagley Street, Gilchrist subdivision, Arbor Lane, Long Rapids Plaza, and Pineview.  
Industrial Park area, U.S. 23 from Hamilton Road to Henry Street, Henry Street and Wilson Street.

**Friday, September 24, 2021 – 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM**

Island View subdivision.
