Alpena Marina High Efficiency Lighting

Contractors for the City of Alpena have begun work on the high efficiency lighting upgrades on the breakwall walkway at the Alpena Marina.

Lights on the breakwall will not be operational for the duration of the project. Users should also be advised, construction equipment will be present for the duration of the project and should avoid using the walkway for the duration of the project.

This project is replacing 24 of the old brown poles with new high efficiency, dark skies compliant low profile bollards and is funded in part by a Community Impact Grant through the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan.

This work is expected to last two (2) weeks unless weather, shipping, or construction delays occur.

The two additional high efficiency lighting projects located on Johnson Street and Washington Avenue Park will be scheduled at a later date.
