## SNOW REMOVAL

With the amount of snow expected and the anticipated blizzard conditions in the coming days, citizens are reminded that the snow clearing efforts will be affected and may take longer in some cases to complete.

MDOT Trunkline is our first priority (Chisholm, Washington, State), then major Streets, then local streets, with public parking areas completed as staff are available.

Considering the amount and duration of the snowfall expected, the trunkline and major streets may need to be cleared several times before DPW personnel are able to move on to the local streets. ***There will be delays clearing the local streets.***

Please give the plow drivers the courtesy of keeping your distance and be aware that plows stop and back-up at intersections frequently.

DPW staff work hard to clear the streets in a safe and efficient manner and as quickly as possible. If they are not working on your street, they are certainly working on another one and will get to yours as time allows.
