### Intersection Closures & Water Shut Off Notice

Beginning Wednesday, May 5, 2021, the intersection of Third Avenue and June Street will be closed to all traffic due to water valve replacement. Traffic at the intersection of Second Avenue and June Street will be maintained to local residents on Second Avenue, between June Street and Oliver Street. Third Avenue traffic will be detoured at June Street to Fifth Avenue.

Additionally, water will be shut off on Wednesday, May 5, 2021, from 8:00 a.m. until approximately 4:00 p.m. **WEATHER PERMITTING.**

The following areas will be affected by the water shut off:

Fourth Avenue from Fowler Drive to Oliver Street  
Sheridan Street from Third Avenue to Fourth Avenue  
Third Avenue from June Street to Franklin Street  
June Street from Third Avenue to First Avenue  
Second Avenue from Ripley to Sheridan Street

### **Please anticipate your water needs before water is shut off.**

When water is restored refrain from drinking, doing laundry, washing dishes or food preparation until water runs clear.

When water is restored there **may be** a boil water notice until two consecutive bacteria samples have been approved. This will take at least two days. **You will be notified if a boil water is required.**

Signage and barricades will be present to guide traffic around the construction site, but motorists are advised to seek alternate routes.

This closure is expected to take one (1) day to complete unless weather or construction delays occur.
