Intersection Closure & Water Shut Off Notice

Due to utility maintenance, the intersection of Chisholm Street and Second Avenue will be closed to all traffic beginning the evening of Monday, November 1, 2021, at 6:30 pm. Traffic at the intersection will be detoured via Old Washington, First Avenue, Water/Carter Street, Third Avenue and Lockwood Street. Signage and Barricades will be present to guide traffic around the construction site, but motorists are advised to seek alternate routes.

Additionally, due to the valve replacement at the intersection of Second Avenue and Chisholm Street, **water MAY be shut off** for a test run on Saturday, October 30, 2021, between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.

Water **WILL BE shut off** Monday, November 1, 2021, from 9:30 pm. until approximately 3:30 a.m.

The following areas will be affected by the water shut off:

Chisholm Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue
Second Avenue from Washington Avenue to Bridge.
River Street from Second Avenue to Third Avenue
Park Place from First Avenue to Second Avenue
Water Street from First Avenue to Second Avenue
Third Avenue from River Street to Lockwood Street
Lockwood Street from Second Avenue to Third Avenue

Please anticipate your water needs before water is shut off.

When water is restored refrain from drinking, doing laundry, washing dishes, or food preparation until water runs clear.

When water is restored there **may be** a boil water notice until two consecutive bacteria samples have been approved. This will take at least two days. **You will be notified if a boil water is required.**

This closure is expected to last one (1) day to complete unless weather or construction delays occur.
