How do I join the meeting?

From a Computer:

Open the link above (A) in any web browser to automatically join the session. Once opened, you will be prompted to join from the web (using the browser-based meeting tool) or from the desktop app.

If you having trouble being automatically launched into session, you can join by manually entering the meeting ID (B). Open a web browser (Chrome preferred) and go to www.gotomeeting.com/meeting/join-meeting and enter the Meeting ID. You can choose to join the meeting from a browser or from the desktop app.

If you are on a computer and have the desktop app installed, you can also join directly by right-clicking the daisy icon in the system tray 🌸 (Windows) or toolbar (Mac), selecting Join and entering the Meeting ID.

When you join from computer, please ensure you test you camera and microphone prior to logging in, the browser-based software will give you an opportunity to do this and adjust as necessary.

From a mobile Device:

First download the [iOS](#), [Android](#) or [Windows Phone](#) app. Then open the app and enter the Meeting ID.

How do I Join the Meeting? (cont'd)

Users that are deaf, hard of hearing, or speech-impaired persons can communicate via TTY equipment by dialing 7-1-1. Individuals who call will be paired with a Communications Assistant. Make sure to give the Communications Assistant the proper teleconference phone number and meeting ID.

How do I communicate?

The meeting will be available to join no later than 15 minutes prior. Please join and become familiar with the interface. Depending on your device or browser, the location will vary, but you need to find and become familiar with the chat window. This is where you will tell Council that you would like to speak.

Please type a “?” in the chat window and send (. This will tell us which microphone to unmute. When the time comes for public to speak, the Mayor will call your name and your microphone will be unmuted. If you are connected through telephone, after others have spoken we will briefly unmute the all users on telephones and you may request to speak. Speaking may only be done at the appropriate time as shown on the Agenda.

Users shall not use the chat window for any other communications/postings. Council and Staff will not respond directly to any questions typed in the chat window. Further, the City will not tolerate inappropriate, lewd, or any other communication that does not apply to the meeting and the Agenda. Violators may be removed from the meeting at the discretion of the Mayor.

Michigan’s Attorney General issued a statement on April 2, instructing that posting certain images and language in video-conferencing sessions can result in criminal charges.

- Don't use a window as a backdrop, others will not be able to see you very well
