Intersection Closure & Water Shut Off Notice

Beginning Monday, October 19, 2020, the intersection of South Second Avenue and Wisner Street will be closed to all traffic due to water valve replacement.

Additionally, water will be shut off on Monday, October 19, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. until approximately 5:00 p.m.

The following areas will be affected by the water shut off:

S. Second Avenue from Blair Street to Bingham Street
Wisner Street from S. First Avenue to S. Third Avenue

Please anticipate your water needs before water is shut off.

When water is restored refrain from drinking, doing laundry, washing dishes or food preparation until water runs clear.

When water is restored there **may be** a boil water notice until two consecutive bacteria samples have been approved. This will take at least two days. **You will be notified if a boil water is required.**

Signage and barricades will be present to guide traffic around the construction site, but motorists are advised to seek alternate routes.

This closure is expected to take one (1) day to complete unless weather or construction delays occur. In case of inclement weather, work will take place the following day.
