City of Alpena Releases Survey for Parks Planning

The City of Alpena, with assistance from the Northeast Michigan Council of Governments (NEMCOG), is updating its Recreation Plan.

A Recreation Plan contains plans for the future of all recreational facilities in the City and is required to be updated every five years. Communities are required to have MDNR-approved Recreation Plans in order to qualify for grant funding from the Michigan DNR.

The planning process incorporates a community participation element that encourages input from citizens. The City of Alpena has chosen to gather this public input in an online survey. The survey takes approximately 5-10 minutes to complete and is available on the City website or at <http://www.discovernortheastmichigan.org/recreation.asp>. Those without internet access may obtain a printed copy from City Hall to complete and return to the Clerk's Office.
