Utility Work & Water Shut Off Notice

Beginning Tuesday, October 22, 2019, the intersections of Clinton Street and Parson Street, Clinton Street and Bingham Street, First Avenue and Wisner Street, and Second Avenue and Bingham Street will be closed to all traffic due to utility repairs. Due to this work, water will be shut off on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, from 8:00 a.m. until approximately 4:00 p.m.

The following areas will be affected by the water shut off:

Clinton Street from Barry Street to Wisner Street
Parson Street from State Street to First Avenue
Bingham Street from Clinton Street to Second Avenue

Please anticipate your water needs before water is shut off.

When water is restored refrain from drinking, doing laundry, washing dishes or food preparation until water runs clear.

When water is restored there may be a boil water notice until two consecutive bacteria samples have been approved. This will take at least two days. **You will be notified if a boil water is required.**

Signage and barricades will be present to guide traffic around the construction site. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

This work will require the complete closure of the intersections on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, unless weather or construction delays occur. Temporary closures should be anticipated over the following two (2) weeks for street repairs to be completed.
