Utility Work & Water Shut Off Notice

Beginning Friday, November 1, 2019, the intersections of First Avenue and Blair Street, Second Avenue and Wisner Street, Third Avenue and Wisner Street, and Second Avenue and Blair Street will be closed to all traffic due to utility repairs. Due to this work, water will be shut off on Friday, November 1, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. until approximately 5:00 p.m.

The following areas will be affected by the water shut off:

Third Avenue from Crapo Street to North Ripley Blvd.
Second Avenue from Bingham Street to Crapo Street
First Avenue from Crapo Street to Wisner Street
Blair Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue
Wisner Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue

Please anticipate your water needs before water is shut off.

When water is restored refrain from drinking, doing laundry, washing dishes or food preparation until water runs clear.

When water is restored there may be a boil water notice until two consecutive bacteria samples have been approved. This will take at least two days. **You will be notified if a boil water is required.**

Signage and barricades will be present to guide traffic around the construction site. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

This work will require the complete closure of the intersections on Friday, November 1, 2019, unless weather or construction delays occur. Temporary closures should be anticipated over the following two (2) weeks for street repairs to be completed.
