Notice is also given that, in accordance with the Commissioner's Court Meeting Rules and Protocols, any person may offer comments to the Commissioner's Court at this meeting on any item listed on the agenda.

In addition, this meeting will also be live-streamed by video conferencing at bellcountytexas.com/county_government/commissioners_court/live_commissioners_court_meeting.php. Members of the Court and/or members of the public may participate and/or comment at this meeting via videoconferencing. Members of the public wishing to participate and/or comment on any item listed on the agenda during the meeting via the video conferencing link *must* register by emailing Shelley.Coston@bellcounty.texas.gov at least one hour prior to 9:00 a.m. on June 5, 2023. You will be given instructions on how to connect and make your comments via email. This meeting will be recorded and the recording will be available on the Bell County's website after the meeting.
