Notice is hereby given that a regular meeting of the above named Court will be held at **9:00 a.m.**, on November 13, 2023, with the meeting to be held in the **COMMISSIONERS' COURTROOM**, at the **Bell County Courthouse, 101 Central Avenue, Belton, Texas**, to begin on November 13, 2023 at **9:00 a.m.**, and continue thereafter until such business of the Court has been completed in accordance with Article 81.005 of the Local Government Code of the State of Texas.

Notice is also given that, in accordance with the Commissioner's Court Meeting Rules and Protocols, any person may offer comments to the Commissioner's Court at this meeting on any item listed on the agenda.

In addition, this meeting will also be live-streamed by video conferencing at bellcountytexas.com/county_government/commissioners_court/live_commissioners_court_meeting.php. Members of the Court and/or members of the public may participate and/or comment at this meeting via videoconferencing.
