ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

- Mr. Todd Buckley and Mrs. Natalie Buckley have applied to MLCC to purchase and transfer an escrowed Class C with Sunday sales permit liquor license from Sagano to Twelve, LLC, DBA Trailhead Town to Trail Outfitters, LLC. The license was issued on January 28, 2025, by the MLCC to Twelve, LLC.
- Brighton City Code 6-32 requires express approval of the Brighton City Council for a new liquor license operation in the City of Brighton.
- The City of Brighton Police department has investigated the applicant business including all stockholders above 10% ownership. A criminal record check reveals the stockholders have no violations.
- The required liquor license application fee has been paid to the City of Brighton.
- The City of Brighton Police Department has determined that the applicant meets the requirements of the City of Brighton's liquor control ordinances (6-31 to 6-41) and therefore recommends approval of the request.

SUBJECT: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE PURCHASE OF TWO 2025 F250 PICKUP TRUCKS FROM LUNGHAMER FORD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$95,135, AND BUILDOUTS OF SAID TRUCKS FROM TRUCK AND TRAILER SPECIALTIES INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$49,803

ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

- Eight years ago, the Department of Public Services implemented a comprehensive vehicle replacement program with the help of the city council by developing the Capital Reserve Fund. This program helps to save on maintenance and repair costs of older vehicles while procuring higher return pricing on vehicles sold while they are still desirable to the public.
- This year, public works staff is asking to replace an eight year old 2017 pickup truck. The replacement for this vehicle would be a 2025 Ford F250 Regular Cab 4x4 Pickup with Snowplow Package. We are also seeking to add a lift gate on the back of the truck. Having a lift gate allows for easier loading and unloading of materials and equipment and is safer for staff. If approved, the 2017 pickup will be sold when the 2025 pickup is delivered. Proceeds from the sale would go back into the Capital Reserve Fund.
- The Water Division is requesting to replace a 2016 service body pickup truck. This vehicle will be replaced with a 2025 Ford F250 chassis and will be fitted with a service body. This style body will continue to allow staff to store and transport all tools and supplies needed to make repairs, change meters and perform MISS Dig operations more efficiently. If approved, the 2016 pickup truck will be sold when the 2025 pickup is delivered. Proceeds from the sale will go back into the Utilities Fund.
