
How to Download and Take a Speedtest[®]

What kind of phone do you have?


Android

Once you have the app, run a Speedtest!



- Open the Speedtest app
- 2. Click the pulsing GO button
- 3. Wait approx 25-30 seconds for the test to complete

Understanding your results

- DOWNLOAD Mbps How fast you pull data from the internet to your device
- OPLOAD Mbps How fast you send data to the internet
- Ping ms Latency (or Ping) is the reaction time of your connection—how quickly your device gets a response
 - Yellow - latency while idle
 - Teal (4) latency while downloading a lot of information
 - o Purple 🕣 latency while uploading heavily
