## CHAMBLEE ANNOUNCES 2023 SUMMER CONCERT SERIES LINE UP

**May 10, 2023** — The City of Chamblee is excited to announce the line up for the 2023 Chamblee Summer Concert Series which will take place at the new, award-winning City Hall (3518 Broad Street, Chamblee, GA 30341).

The concert series will kick off with music through the decades on **Friday, June 2, at 6:30 PM** as The Breakfast Club and Saved by the Band play crowd favorites from the 80s and 90s. As the longest running, most recognized 80s tribute band, The Breakfast Club formed in 1993 with the mission to create a group that embodied the enigmatic, creative and buoyant spirit of music and performances of the original MTV generation of the 1980s. Titled after the 90s sitcom, Saved by the Band is known for playing the songs you know and love. Both bands will give a performance that will take you on a journey through the decades!

In traditional Chamblee fashion, the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration returns on **Tuesday, July 4, at 6:30 PM** in a new location – Chamblee City Hall (3518 Broad Street). Nashville-based, Georgia-native Leah Belle Faser will prepare attendees for a party they never experienced, a party thrown by The Geek Squad Band. Once the music stops, around 9 pm, the fireworks begin! With the celebration relocating, options for transportation to City Hall will be provided including a shuttle, parking at nearby businesses, and utilizing the City's new rideshare park which is a short walk from City Hall.
