Chamblee City Hall Wins Construction Management Association of America South Atlantic Chapter Project Achievement Award

July 19, 2023 —Chamblee’s new City Hall continues to win prestigious awards for its construction and design. The state-of-the-art facility was recently awarded the 2023 Construction Management Association of America (CMAA) South Atlantic Chapter (SAC) Project Achievement Award in new construction for a municipal project under \$20 million. This award recognizes outstanding achievement in the practice of construction management and promotes professionalism and excellence in the management of the construction process. The builder for Chamblee City Hall, Reeves + Young, nominated the project for the award.

“Our goal was to create a space that would serve as a community gathering spot for years to come,” said Mayor Brian Mock. “Reeves + Young exceeded our expectations in building a beautiful and welcoming facility that we can all be proud of. This building serves as a daily reminder that Chamblee’s future remains bright.”

All projects submitted for the award must have been managed from or constructed in the geographic boundaries of the SAC (Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina, and Tennessee). This is the second prestigious award in recent months that the City of Chamblee has won for its new City Hall. The City previously won the American Institute of Architects (AIA) Georgia 2023 People’s Choice Award for best built project over 5,000 square feet. Chamblee’s new City Hall opened in October of last year. It was designed by Goodwyn Mills Cawood (GMC) and built by Reeves + Young and serves as a centerpiece for the City’s developing downtown.
