Chamblee City Hall Wins American Institute of Architects Georgia People’s Choice Award

Voted Best Built Project Over 5,000 Square Feet

April 21, 2023 — The City of Chamblee’s state-of-the-art City Hall received hundreds of votes to win the American Institute of Architects (AIA) Georgia 2023 People’s Choice Award for best built project over 5,000 square feet. The award was presented to Goodwyn Mills Cawood (GMC) for designing Chamblee’s City Hall. GMC officials and Chamblee Mayor Brian Mock attended an official ceremony on April 15th to accept the award.

“I’m so pleased that GMC invited me to share in this celebration,” said Mayor Brian Mock. “We had asked them to design a building reflecting our past, but with vision towards our future. They exceeded our expectations. I’m thrilled that those voting found it every bit as beautiful as we do daily.”

Chamblee’s new City Hall opened in October of last year. It was designed by Goodwyn Mills Cawood (GMC) and built by Reeves Young and serves as a centerpiece for the City’s developing downtown. Chamblee’s City Hall creates a welcoming and inviting environment with a variety of open green spaces that promote public engagement and activity. It also houses a number of city departments which includes the City Clerk, City Manager’s Office, Economic Development, Finance, Human Resources, Parks & Recreation, Community Engagement and Public Relations. Chamblee’s new City Hall is located at 3518 Broad Street, Chamblee, GA 30341.
