CHAMBLEE POLICE FIND CHILD AND SUSPECTS IN CHILD ABDUCTION CASE

August 29, 2020 –The two suspects wanted in today’s child abduction case in Chamblee, Ga., are now in custody. Chamblee Police officers found them in Carrollton, Ga. with the child in unharmed. The suspects were stopped by Georgia State Patrol, along with local authorities, in the red 2003 Acura MDX with GA tag RTJ0253 at around 5:00 p.m. They will remain in custody in Carroll County.

On Saturday, August 29 at approximately 12:30 p.m., officers from the Chamblee Police Department responded to 8 Clairview Drive on a child abduction call. The victim was walking to her apartment with her one-year-old child in the stroller. The two suspects, both Hispanic males in their mid- to late-20s, exited the car and walked toward her. The second suspect got out and grabbed her son and got back into the vehicle.

The Federal Bureau of Investigations will take over the case.
