June 5, 2018—The City of Chamblee wants residents to join the “Community Dialogue” about their neighborhood at two interactive listening sessions. The focus of these meetings is on neighborhoods, development and sustainability.

- The June 21st meeting will be held at St. Pius X Catholic High School Cafeteria, 2674 Johnson Rd NE.
- Both meetings begin at 6:00 p.m., are scheduled to last three hours and are open to all Chamblee residents.

Urban redevelopment area-related sessions during Wednesday’s dialogue will focus on development opportunities for the Savoy Drive and Chamblee Tucker Road/Buford Highway intersection areas, while Thursday’s dialogue will focus on the Shallowford Road/Interstate 85 intersection and Dresden Park areas.

Participants will be divided into groups as this is a hands-on, interactive activity, where there’s an opportunity to provide feedback on existing city policies and future initiatives. Do not miss your chance to help shape the future of Chamblee. Discussion topics include trees, smart growth, redevelopment, code enforcement, crime prevention through environmental design, neighborhood planning and more.
