A children's (ages 14 and younger) celebration will be held on Tuesday, August 1, 2017, from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. Neighborhoods host block parties, festivals, parades, cookouts and various other community events with safety demonstrations, seminars, youth events, visits from emergency personnel, exhibits and much, much more.

“The goal of National Night Out is to create a safe and healthy community, and to forge partnerships between our police officers and our residents,” said Chamblee Police Chief Donny Williams. “Millions of neighbors across the world take place in this partnership, and I’m so glad Chamblee can be a part of this movement to make the world a better place.”

Nationwide, last year's event involved residents, law enforcement agencies, civic groups, businesses, neighborhood organizations and local officials from more than 16,000 communities in all 50 states. In all, more than 38 million people participated in NNO.
