All proceeds from the purchase of food or drinks go to the vendors. People who want to attend A Taste of Chamblee but are not interested in purchasing any food or beverages do NOT need to download the app. Charging stations will also be available throughout the event space to charge up your phone. Cashless options will also be available.
