Chamblee City Manager Announces Resignation

October 19, 2023 — City Manager Jon Walker has announced his resignation as the City Manager for the City of Chamblee. Walker was appointed as interim City Manager in May 2016 and was made permanent in September 2016. Under his leadership, the City of Chamblee has seen significant growth and development. During his tenure, the City has built a new state-of-the-art City Hall, a new Public Safety Complex with Arrow Creek Park, Peachtree Road Streetscape, and expansion of the Rail Trail through the mid-city district. Walker and team also developed the Nonprofit Partnership Program, established the Community Engagement Department, Communications Department, and transformed the City's downtown into an active/entertainment district.

"I've thoroughly enjoyed my time in Chamblee and am so impressed with the strong, dedicated and innovative people who work here," said Jon Walker, City Manager for the City of Chamblee. "Chamblee has always been a dream job for me, to create a more walkable and active community. I look forward to embarking on a new opportunity that continues to serve people."

Walker will continue to serve as City Manager for the City of Chamblee until the end of November.
