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The following information should be considered by offerors in preparation of their Bids:

## Bidder's Questions:

1. After reviewing the Bidding Documents for the 5300 Peachtree Road Sidewalk and Landscaping Improvements project, I did not see an explicit Pre-Bid meeting date for the project. Could you please help us by confirming the date for this meeting?

*No pre-bid meeting will be held for this project.*

2. Do you anticipate utility conflicts between the structures A-2 and A-1 with Gas, Electric and Telecommunication lines?

*Utility conflicts may exist with proposed drainage system. Coordination with utility owners is on-going. If relocations are required, they will need to be coordinated by the Contractor.*

3. Do you have a utility relocation schedule for this project?

*See response above for Question #2.*

4. Please include a line item for the removal of the existing lights.

*Removal, storage, and return to owner of existing lights shall be included in Rem Lighting Standard, Line item 40.*

*Addenda 1 provides the revised specification section 004100, which includes the added line item 40.*

5. Due to the lead time for new poles and lights (more than 90 days), it will not be possible to complete the project within 90 days. However, we propose the following options:

\* Build the pole's foundation in the time frame of the project and come back with the lights when they arrive.

\* Relocate the existing lights (temporarily), while waiting for the delivery of the ones.

Please, advice what would be the best way to proceed.



*Construction of new pole shall be done in a manner to expedite installation of new lighting, such that any elements of the lighting that can be installed during initial grading (conduit, foundations) shall be constructed as soon as possible.*

*An administrative NTP can be issued to allow the procurement of materials with long lead times, however construction shall be completed within 90 calendar days. Temporary relocation of the existing lights are not required and should not be included in the contractor's bid.*

6. Locations of structures A-1 and A-2 on Drawing No. 54-0001 do not match with location of structures on Drawing No. 22-0001. They seem to be swapped. Please clarify the correct locations for these structures.

*Drainage structures A-1 and A-2 labels are swapped on 22-0001. Plan labels are correct with A-2 being a Drop Inlet located at Sta. 101+57 and A-1 being a manhole located at Sta. 101+40. This will be revised on the plans, post award.*

7. The plans show new poles, what is to be done with the existing ones?

*Existing light poles are to be removed and returned to owner. Cost of this to be included in line item 40, Rem Lighting Standard.*

*Addenda 1 provides the revised specification section 004100, which includes the added line item 40.*

8. Will the existing pavers be removed and replaced with new ones?

*Existing pavers shall be removed and salvaged as indicated in the plans. New pavers shall be installed in locations identified in the plans.*
