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GUIDELINES FOR SAFE WALKING ROUTE MAPS

The purpose of this booklet is to provide safe walking routes for children on their way to and from school. Each map has been designed to be as user-friendly as possible, utilizing symbols and street names to help guide the way. The creation of this booklet is just the beginning of the process: school administrators, teachers, and parents need to work together with their children to educate them about the routes and why they are important. There are many ways that these maps can be used:

- Teachers can show their students the safe walking route map for their school. They can lead a discussion as to why children should use the routes and what hazards they should avoid while walking to and from school.
- Parents can walk the route with their children so that they are fully able to walk to and from school on their own.

• Teachers and/or parents can form a "walking school bus" program, where a different parent volunteers to walk a group of children to school every day, thus providing more security for both parents and children. - Students can form a buddy system, meeting at a designated place along the route and walking to and from

school together.

• Schools can identify "safe houses" that students can go to along the routes in case they feel they are in danger.

Designated routes should be reviewed and revised whenever there are changes in the route such as construction, a new traffic signal, or when changes are made to the school service boundaries.

The level of safety for students will increase through the use of well-designed school routes. The map should receive the widest possible circulation to teachers, students, parents, and local entities such as the police, media, and city governments.

SAFE WALKING ROUTES SELECTION PROCESS

The Safe Walking Routes maps for schoolchildren were developed as a product to be distributed in the schools to children who walk to school. The maps illustrate routes children can take that are safer because they take into account:

- Sidewalks
- Crosswalks
- Pedestrian-related signage
- Provision of adult crossing guards
- Number of lanes crossed
- Traffic volumes
- Traffic control devices (i.e. stoplights, stop signs, etc.)
- Posted speed limits

The criteria were applied in the following order:

1. A roadway inventory for the above factors was completed for walking areas around each participating school.

2. Any routes that did not have sidewalks were disregarded unless there was no other possible route to be taken.

3. Point values were assigned for each safety factor; for those routes with equal totals, the individual nature of each

route was considered in terms of stop sign orientation, vehicular access points, and safety of street crossings.

4. Arrows were drawn given the above factors; at least one safe route from each principal direction was provided. Arrows were provided on just one side of a street on numerous routes, reflecting lack of a sidewalk on one side or better crossing conditions for the students.

5. City engineers, police, school administration, and staff reviewed the maps for accuracy and safety factors unique to each school.

6. Staff revised any recommendations and made changes accordingly.







- Always walk on sidewalks or paths separated from vehicular traffic. If there are no sidewalks or paths, always walk on the side of the street FACING road traffic, as far to the left as possible.
- Dress to be seen. Wear bright-colored clothes so drivers can easily see you. At night, wear retroreflective materials on your shoes, cap, or jacket to reflect the headlights of cars coming towards you. If it is dark or hard to see, you may also carry a flashlight.
- Obey all adult crossing guards.
- Obey all signs, signals, and traffic lights.
- Always look for vehicles backing up when crossing driveways, and look for traffic at every driveway and intersection.
- Tips for crossing the street safely:
 - Cross only at corners or marked crosswalks. Never cross in the middle of the road unsupervised.
 - When available, cross at a location with an adult crossing guard. Otherwise, cross the street with an adult whenever possible.
 - If a car is parked where you are crossing, look for a driver in the car they may be getting ready to move. If there

is not a driver in the car, go to the edge of the car, look left-right-left, and only cross the street when no cars are coming.

- If no cars are parked where you are crossing, stop at the curb, or the edge of the road. Look left, right, and left again, before you step into the street. Also look behind and in front of you for traffic.
- Wait until no traffic is coming, and begin crossing.
- Always walk when crossing the street never run! You could trip and fall when running.
- Keep looking for traffic and make eye contact with drivers until you have finished crossing.
- When crossing the street at a signalized intersection:
 - Stop at the curb or edge of the road.
 - If a pedestrian pushbutton exists, push it to activate the "WALK" signal.
 - If the "WALK" signal is lit, look left-right-left for traffic before crossing the street. Also, look behind and in front of you for turning vehicles.
 - If the "DON'T WALK" signal is flashing, wait for the next new "WALK" signal. It will give you the most time to cross the street.



- If you are in the middle of the street, and the "DON'T WALK" signal begins to flash, don't stop or return to the curb or edge of the road. Continue to walk at your maximum comfortable pace until you reach the other side. Walk, don't run – you could fall if you run.
- If a pedestrian countdown signal exists at the intersection, it will tell you how many seconds you have left to cross.
- Walk with a friend when possible.
- When you are near the street, don't push, shove, or chase other walkers.
- If any bullying happens during your walk, talk to your parents and teacher.
- Ask your parents or caregivers to help you use the Safe Walking Route Maps (https://ccrpc.org/documents/ safe-walking-route-maps/) to pick a safe route to school one that avoids dangers. Stick to the route you picked with your parents. Don't let friends talk you into shortcuts that are more dangerous.
- When determining your safe walking route to school, limit the number of street crossings, and avoid crossing busy or high-speed streets.

• Parents/caregivers should walk with younger children or children walking to a new school to make sure they know the route and can walk it safely.

• Parents/caregivers should use their child's pedestrian skills and experience to determine when their child is ready to walk to school without adult supervision, not a set age. It takes time and practice for children to accurately judge the speed, distance, and size of oncoming vehicles.

- Always wear a correctly fitted bicycle helmet, no matter how short or long the ride. It should be snug and level on the head.
- Find a safe place to ride younger children (especially under age 10) should ride on the sidewalk or pathway.
- Follow the rules of the road when riding your bike in the street.
- Stay on the right side when riding your bike in the street, in a straight, single-file line, in the same direction as auto traffic.
- Use appropriate hand signals when riding in the street.
- Obey all signs and traffic lights.
- Stay off busy streets.
- When crossing the street, look left, then right, then left again, making eye contact with drivers.
- If you approach a busy street, get off your bike when you get to the curb, look left, right, and left again, make eye contact with drivers, and walk your bike across the street.
- Always watch for vehicles when crossing driveways or alleys.

- Never carry riders on your bike.
- Never ride between cars.
- Give pedestrians the right-of-way.
- Stay alert for unexpected obstacles.
- Make sure your bike has a white headlight and rear red reflector if you are riding in the street at night, as it is an Illinois state law.
- Always make sure your bike is in good repair.
- Make sure you have no clothing or laces hanging down that can catch in the spokes.
- Wear bright-colored and/or reflective clothing to increase your visibility.



LEAL SCHOOL: WALKING & BICYCLING GUIDELINES

Bicycles

- Students may ride bicycles to school with parental approval, but traffic around Leal is very congested. The school recommends that younger children not ride bikes to school.
- Please do not ride bikes across the playground or on the sidewalks adjacent to the school property.
- Bikes should be parked in the bicycle racks on the east side of the school building immediately upon arrival at the school.
- Students riding bicycles should observe proper traffic and safety rules at all times.
- All bicycles should have locks and chains and be securely fastened to bicycle racks.
- Bicycles should be registered with the Urbana Police Department.
- The bicycle racks at Leal are very difficult to supervise. Bicycle thefts and vandalism have occasionally been a problem in the past.
- Parents and students should consider using any established "bike paths" as often as possible.
- Please be sure your child can handle a bicycle safely before granting permission to ride to and from school.

Student Safety To and From School

- Please use one of the designated safe walking routes to school.
- Please discuss the importance of obeying the directions of crossing guards with your child.
- Students walking from the south should use Birch St. where Urbana Police crossing guards are available.
- Students coming from the east and needing to cross Broadway and Race should use Oregon St., as crossing guards are stationed at those locations.


Supervision Before and After School

Bicicletas


Supervisión Antes y Después de la Escuela
