#### F. Commissioner's Report

**Commissioner Garcia-** Wants to announce that they are having their Ramah Navajo fair and rodeo that started today. Started this morning with a blessing at 6 o'clock and a health walk among other activities. It will continue until Sunday.

Commissioner Lowery- There are two meetings to present. The first is the San Mateo meeting, thanks to Joanna Martinez she brought pizza and set the meeting up. Met with about fourteen people, what's really interesting is there was an equal amount of men and women. Their two priorities are cleaning their ditches and getting high speed internet. They are also concerned about their pending water issues, when they are irrigating during the day the water is used up

and the water tank is low at night. This probably going to be very common for our communities, the issue with water. There's no plan what they are going to do with that. On September 22<sup>nd</sup> they have the San Mateo feast and everyone is invited. The second meeting was with representation with Laguna. We talked about County Rd 81 you will recognize that it has been vacated with their permission. We had open discussions about the Census, we will be sharing a float with them for the Laguna Feast Parade on September 19<sup>th</sup>.

**Commissioner Lucero-** Had a meeting with US Representative Xochitl Torres Small at the library. She gave us her input on the stuff she is going through and she's guarantee that she would look at and study some of the issues that we have.

Commissioner Windhorst- Three weeks ago had a cleanup in Bluewater Acres South. We had some dumpsters out there and cleaned up around the Fire Dept and got to meet a lot of nice people. Had a cleanup two weeks ago in Mt Taylor Addition we had three large dumpsters we had one that was designated for tire removal. We filled all those dumpsters and pounded them down and filled them again and again. Had got a call from a State Representative that wasn't happy that we were having a cleanup in Mt Taylor Addition when our County properties look so bad. He asked why we weren't out there cleaning those up. Kate informed me that the County has contracted with a local company and they are going to be taking care of the County properties. They will make sure the weeds are cut down and that our properties look sharp. Grateful to everyone in the County for stepping up and helping with the cleanups. Our communities are looking really good.

**Commissioner Torrez-** Would like to thank the Road Dept and Gary. He's been out there busy and now that everything is falling into place some of the roads are getting improved in everyone's District

#### G. Public Comment

Ronnie Pynes- Would like to thank the County Commissioners, Kate Fletcher and Paul for holding the workshop meeting. It was a good meeting and helped the community better understand more specifics about the hospital issue. It was a great opportunity for all of us and would like to thank our legal counsel. Secondly would like to go on public record about the shooting range issue. Hasn't seen or heard anything about if for some time. Wants to one more time ask if we as a County and County Commissioners to actively put a facility in place to take our sons, daughters and grandkids to train. We have several hundred thousand acres of public land in this area. We should have a legal shooting range where we can go shoot train and teach. Would like to ask the Commissioners if maybe about quarterly put this as an agenda item so we could get an update.

**Les Gaines-** We have a Forest Service meeting coming up believes it is September 7<sup>th</sup>. It is a public meeting concerning the forest plan provision, it will be in the old County complex 515 W. High St. He is the point of contact for the Mt Taylor/ Zuni Mountain Collaborate. When you get to the Resolution 19-57 if you have any questions on that he is here to answer them.

#### I. Reports

- Finance Report-Paul Ludi- Finance Director- Kate was informed of an article today, supposedly our detention center is in crisis. This is false reporting, this is what the article said about our detention center. They think that we are losing a lot of money because we are not getting reimbursed from ICE. That's not a true statement we are a flow through agency we are actually earning administrative fees. Kate- Spoke with one of the reporters and they actually thought that we owned the Core Civic Detention Center and that we are the ones running it. This whole statement is incorrect, spoke to the reporter this afternoon and she was going to report it this evening but now she is not. We actually have a contract with ICE where we get administrative fees for each inmate. In fact the County does not have a detention center anymore we pay detention costs for County inmates only not ICE inmates. Cibola County is actually the flow through between Core Civic, ICE and US Marshalls. Cibola County has not lost money from ICE but has actually earned \$60,734.92. Cibola County's final budget has been approved by the Dept of Finance and Administration. There was only one change to the LEPF Fund. It is now projected to expend the entire LEPF distribution and carryover balance. Contacted the Dept of Health and our EMS providers to inform them of the balances not used by our Emergency Medical Services. EMS funding is a lot less than our fire protection funds because the distributions are rarely used during the year. We will be encouraging our EMS providers to use the funding if they are receiving it. Only Superior Ambulance has an insignificant balance leftover that they will not be required to submit a carryover request. Cibola County has been on the State Auditor's "At Risk List" the past 2 years because of the disclaimer and adverse opinions the County has received. Cibola is the only County to be on the list the prior 2 fiscal years in FY17 and FY18. Everyone has worked really hard to clean up the audit finding's this year. We are looking forward to the County's FY19 audit and getting off the "At Risk List".
- Manager Report-Kate Fletcher-County Manager- Have had a very busy month. Juanita has discussed the landscaping of the buildings, we did hire a contractor to take of that he did start today. Have a list for the commissioners of the NM County Committee descriptions. We have a lot of road we are reviewing with Anna, Gary and

Commissioner Lucero, we are doing pretty well this month and ready to address some of the roads now. Have also had some meetings with Laguna and Acoma in regards to what projects we can work on and how we can work together. We talked to them. We do have a meeting with Zuni coming up. Anna is in charge of the Census she's doing her first training. The County is actually getting money to help with the Census. We have been working on drainage and flooding areas. We had a workshop with the hospital it was very educating and interesting. Have some really good news, Pearl our Chief Deputy Treasurer has been working every day and every night to fix a material weakness finding from last year and years prior. She has actually reconciled the account, now she is going to work on another material weakness.

## BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE 2019-002

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SYSTEM OF LOCAL BUSINESS REGISTRATION; PROHIBITING OPERATING AN UNREGISTERED BUSINESS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 3-18-1 (1972) provides that municipalities have the power to "protect generally the property of its municipality and its inhabitants" and to "preserve peace and order"; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 3-38-3 provides that municipalities have the authority to charge a business registration fee on each place of business conducted within a municipality.

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 4-37-1 grants Counties the same powers that are granted municipalities except for those powers that are inconsistent with statutory or constitutional limitations placed on counties.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cibola adopts the following Ordinance establishing registration requirements for business conducted within unincorporated areas of the County.

#### Section 1. SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the Cibola County Business Registration Ordinance.

#### Section 2. JURISDICTION

This Ordinance shall apply to all unincorporated areas of Cibola County but not to areas within a federally created Indian Reservation.

#### Section 3. DEFINITIONS

<u>Combined Reporting System ("CRS") Tax Identification Number</u>. A tax identification number used to report and pay tax collected on gross receipts from business conducted in New Mexico.

Engaging in Business. Persons or entities operating, conducting, doing, carrying on, causing to be carried on, or pursuing any business, profession, occupation, trade, pursuit or activity for the purpose of profit and who are required to obtain a CRS Identification Number pursuant to New Mexico law and pay or should pay Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax (GRT) pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 7-9-1, et. seq. to the State of New Mexico, then the business must be registered. Specifically excepted are athletic officials who officiate for any association or organization that regulates any public school activity and whose rules and regulations are approved by the State Board of Education.

<u>Place of Business</u>. The premises, whether it be a personal residence, mail business location, or an outlet, branch or other location thereof, temporary or otherwise, to which the public is expressly or impliedly invited for the purpose of transacting business. In the event there is no such location, but the business is transacted at the location of the buyer, then the general sales area shall be considered a place of business.

### Section 4. REGISTRATION/RENEWAL/FEES REQUIRED

- A. Any person or entity engaged in business must complete a County Business Registration Form for each place of business within the jurisdiction of the County between January 1 and March 1, 2020 and must renew each subsequent year by March 1.
- B. The Business Registration Form is due thirty (30) days after new business is commenced or place of business added.
- C. The County Clerk, with the input of the Planning Coordinator, is authorized to promulgate application forms and to create and maintain records of registration. A current CRS number must be provided on each registration and renewal form.
- D. Registration and renewal forms must be signed by the County Clerk, the Planning Coordinator, and a representative from the County Assessor's Office before registration is complete.
- E. Yearly fees are assessed at thirty-five dollars (\$35.00). Fees will not be prorated.

#### Section 5. UNLAWFUL CONDUCT

1. It shall be unlawful for any person who is required by New Mexico law to obtain a CRS Identification Number and/or to pay GRT to engage in business within the County's jurisdiction without registering the business and complying with the terms of this Ordinance.

 It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly file an application for issuance or renewal of any business registration on which any of the information required has been falsified.

#### Section 6. PENALTIES and ENFORCEMENT

- 1. A fine of up to three hundred dollars (\$300.00) may be imposed pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 3-17-1(C)(1).
- 2. In addition to a fine, the County may institute at any time up to four (4) years following the violation any appropriate judicial action or proceeding to:
  - a. Prevent the conduct of the business;
  - b. Prevent the occupancy of the building, structure or land on which the business is located;
  - c. Collect fees by suit in court; or
  - d. Charge a late fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) per year for registration renewal payments made after the due date of March 15.
- 3. Unpaid registration fees constitute a lien in favor of the County and may be enforced according to any available legal provisions.
- 4. The Sheriff's Office and the Planning Coordinator are authorized to issue citations pursuant to Paragraph 1 of this Section; and, the County Attorneys are authorized to carry out enforcement activities pursuant to Paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Section.

#### Section 7. REPEALER

Ordinance 91-02 is hereby repealed.

#### Section 8. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Commission hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, sub-section, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

#### NOMINAL PURCHASES POLICY

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, September 26, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in the Cibola County Administration Building 700 Roosevelt, Grants, New Mexico 87020; and,

WHEREAS, NMSA, 1978, Section 4-38-18 (1976) provides that a Board of County Commissioner has the duty and authority "[t]o represent the county and have the care of the county property and the management of the interest of the county in all cases where no other provision is made by law; and,

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 3-13-4 (1965) allows municipalities and counties to establish a personnel merit system for the hiring, promotion, discharge and general regulation of municipal and county employees; and,

WHEREAS, N.M. Const. art. IX, § 14, the Anti-Donation Clause, generally prohibits state or local governments from making out right gifts to persons, nevertheless the Attorney General has interpreted the anti-donation clause to allow public entities to spend public money to achieve their governmental purposes even when the expenditures provide an incidental benefit to private individuals or entities, as long as the benefit, based on the amount, duration, frequency or other characteristic, does not amount to an actual grant or subsidy condemned by the clause, See N.M.A.G. Op. No. 97-02 (Jan. 7, 1997).

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the following policy is hereby adopted.

#### NOMINAL PURCHASE POLICY

I. Purpose.

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to County Administration regarding the purchase and distribution of employee recognition mementos, advertising materials for public safety awareness campaigns, recruitment events and promotional occasions.

- II. Employee Retirement or Recognition Awards
  - A. As a prospective benefit to County Service, Cibola County employees are eligible to receive:
    - 1. A retirement plaque or other gift purchased by the County, the value of which may not exceed \$50.00.
    - 2. Service Awards or Employee Appreciation Awards (such as lapel pins, medallions, paperweights, clocks, plaques, etc.) upon the completion of important employment anniversary milestones, i.e., 5, 10, 15 years of continuous employment, the value of which may not exceed \$25.00.
  - B. County Administration is authorized to purchase such items pursuant to the limitations imposed by the New Mexico Procurement Code, NMSA 1978, 13-1-128 et seq., the current County small purchasing policy and consistent with the County's budget.
  - C. Retirement and Service Awards will originate from the Human Resources Department and will be submitted to the County Manager for authorization.
  - D. Employee Appreciation Awards must originate from the Department Director or Elected Official and be submitted to the County Manager for authorization. Examples of reasons for authorizing an Employee Appreciation Award include:
    - 1. Valor (life-saving, bravery, heroism, courageous)
    - 2. Significant Monetary Savings to Cibola County
    - 3. Significant Professional Contribution
- III. Public Safety Awareness Campaigns, Recruitment Events and Promotional Occasions
  - A. County departments are authorized to procure promotional materials such as pens, flyers, t-shirts, children's toy badges *etc*. and distribute those items during public safety and awareness campaigns, recruitment events or occasions which promote Cibola County services if:
    - 1. The items do not exceed \$10 per individual item.
    - 2. All program participants or event attendees are eligible to receive the items.
    - 3. The items are rationally designed to build public trust & confidence in the County's departments, educate the public on public safety issues, promote interest

- in building a career with the County, and/or inform the Public of services offered by Cibola County.
- B. County Administration is authorized to purchase such items pursuant to the limitations imposed by the New Mexico Procurement Code, NMSA 1978, 13-1-128 *et seq.*, the current County small purchasing policy and consistent with the County's budget.
