RESOLUTION 2023-17

**DEDICATING LOCAL ASSISTANCE AND TRIBAL CONSISTENCY FUNDING TO
CIBOLA COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Cibola County, met in a meeting on February 8th, at 3:00 pm in the Cibola County Commission Chamber, 700 East Roosevelt Ave. Suite 50, Grants, NM 87021; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cibola exercises the powers of the County as a body politic and corporate pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 4-38-1(1884); and,

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 4-37-1 (1995) provides that Counties have the power to, “provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity and improve the morals, order, comfort and convenience of any county or its inhabitants”; and,

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan appropriated \$2 billion to Treasury across fiscal years 2022 and 2023 to provide payments to eligible revenue sharing counties and eligible Tribal governments for use on any governmental purpose except for a lobbying activity; and,

WHEREAS, Cibola County has broad discretion on the use of the Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund (“LACTF”) funds; and,

WHEREAS, the County has a statutory responsibility to maintain public highways within its jurisdiction, except those within the corporate limits of any incorporated city or town or owned and operated by private corporations, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-2-2 (1905); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the vital role the County’s road infrastructure plays in the day to day lives of its residents, and its responsibility to continue to maintain and improve County road infrastructure.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Cibola County that it hereby directs its Administration to work with the County’s road committee to develop a widescale county infrastructure plan for this Board’s consideration.




