RESOLUTION NO. 2022-06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON,
ADOPTING THE GRANITE FALLS WATER SYSTEM PLAN DECEMBER 2022.**

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health requires that water purveyors update their Water System Plan every ten years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls ("City") has completed updating its Water System Plan; and

WHEREAS, on April 19, 2022 a draft Water System Plan was sent to Snohomish County PUD No. 1, Snohomish Health District and Snohomish County Planning and Development Services; and

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2022 the City completed the SEPA process for the Water System Plan, a Declaration of Nonsignificance was issued and no comments related to the SEPA publication were subsequently received; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2022 the City issued its revised 2022 Water System Plan to the Washington State Department of Health after receiving and incorporating comments from Snohomish County Planning and the Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, the City has separately reviewed and approved the proposed Water Use Efficiency goals stated within the 2022 Water System Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Granite Falls City Council motioned to approve the Water System Plan as revised; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby adopts the December 2022 Water System Plan.
