**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON
DECLARING AS SURPLUS OFFICE EQUIPMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls no longer has a need for the furnishings, vehicles and equipment owned by the City as listed in Exhibit "A"; and,

WHEREAS, the City registered with the Public Surplus Government Surplus Auctions site on April 20, 2020 to utilize their service to auction items deemed as public surplus by the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City also uses other local auction services provided by James G. Murphy Company; and,

WHEREAS, the City also has the right to use online marketplaces such as Craigslist and Offer Up to sell surplus items at fair market value to the first responsive buyer in compliance with state law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Items and equipment listed on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution are declared as surplus furnishings, vehicles and equipment to the City of Granite Falls.


Section 2. These surplus items are to be sold by public auction through the site identified above or through other acceptable means such as James G. Murphy Auction or an online marketplace for the best value available.

Section 3. These surplus items are to be transferred/sold in "as is" condition, with no warranty either expressed or implied as to completeness or suitability for any purpose whatsoever.

Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution should be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or

unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City of Granite Falls City Council.
