

RESOLUTION 81-8
RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, understand that the members of the County Council of the County of Snohomish, is presently considering, among other things connected with the District Court of Snohomish County, the proposition of consolidating the activities of the outlying Courts including Cascade District Court, Arlington, Washington;

WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the members of the Town Council of Granite Falls that this may include the consolidation of the District Courts in the City of Everett to hear the City cases now heard in Arlington;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Granite Falls, believes that this would be detrimental to the best interests of the Town of Granite Falls and similar cities resulting in greater expense to the Town of Granite Falls in the cost of requiring cases to be tried in the City of Everett and the inconveniences to the citizens of the Town of Granite Falls involved in criminal and civil actions in the District Court;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls that the members of the County Council of the County of Snohomish be advised and made aware of the Town Council of Granite Falls's opposition to the consolidation of the District Courts in the City of Everett.
